With your donation you can assist us in providing a Treasure Log/activity book for children and teens.

Children who come to Stollery for treatment need some creative diversion from their medical treatments and sometimes lengthy hospital stays. These books have lots of fun activities and come complete with colored pencils, pens and stickers.

\$50

A child's treasure bead necklace! Each time a patient undergoes a medical procedure, such as a needle, blood test or CT scan, the child receives a bead. Together, the beads provide kids with an avenue to talk about their treatments and what they are going through.

\$500 to \$1000

Families sometimes need specialized medical equipment in order to care for children at home Your donation could fund an INR machine that will monitor the thickness or thinness of a child's blood thus helping to reduce the incidence of stroke. Oximeters are needed to monitor oxygen saturation and are often required by children with corrected or waiting for correction heart conditions. Other examples include blood pressure monitors, baby weigh scales and 24 hour heart monitors.

\$2000 and over

Funding new technologies at the UHF and Stollery Children's Hospital helps to ensure vital diagnostic equipment is available for cardiology staff. Yearly contributions are made for this purpose.
